Student Benefits



College Preparation: Studies show that SU concurrent enrollment courses offered through Project Advance provide a unique opportunity for college-bound seniors to see how well they will transition from high school to college and to gauge their ability to do typical first-year college work.

College Credit: More than 90% (+/- 2% in any given year) of SUPA graduates who send an official SU transcript or attend SU receive college recognition—credit, placement, and/or exemption—for completed SU coursework.

Great Expectations: Data suggest that SUPA graduates are highly motivated achievers. To college admissions officials, such students are desirable, low-risk prospects who are unlikely to drop out, seldom seek time-shortened degrees, and often go on to graduate study.

Greater Challenges: SUPA offers genuine SU courses, so the coursework is more demanding than high school coursework. Students are expected conceptualize and draw conclusions from reading and research. As a result, SUPA graduates tend to be more adaptable, self-actuated, reflective, and innovative.
