Chile Course Registration FAQ

What information do I need to register?

Information necessary to register includes student name, permanent home address, student and parent e-mail addresses, date of birth, home phone, and parent cellphone. Students from Chile will access the online course application by choosing Chile, the location where you attend high school. Please note that no Social Security number is required.

How much does it cost to enroll in a Syracuse University course?

The tuition rate is \$115.00 per credit hour (e.g., a 3-credit course = \$345.00)

How do I pay for the Syracuse University course?

Visit PASS (credit card only) https://pass.digitalservices.syr.edu/

Click on Parent /Guardian then click on Pay Tuition for International Student

Parents/ Guardians sign in utilizing the student's email address and password that were established when the online application was completed, then click on **Pay Tuition** or **View bill and make payment**.

Who can register to take SU courses

through Project Advance?

Course offerings are normally restricted to qualified high school seniors. However, students in their junior year are sometimes allowed to enroll in Project Advance sections of SU courses with approval from the appropriate Project Advance administrator and university faculty coordinator.

How do I register for classes?

Chile students access the online application to register for courses by choosing Chile, the location where you attend high school. A Student Registration Guide is posted on our website and also distributed to your Instructor via Email.

Can I register for an SU course if I am not a US citizen?

Yes. All international students must register through the Global SUPA Students portal, accessed through the PASS registration system.
