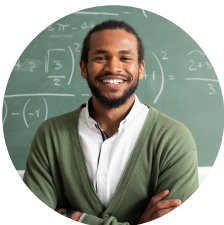


## Student Benefits

Clear Expectations - SUPA graduates say they are aware of the necessary study skills and responsibility required in the college setting.



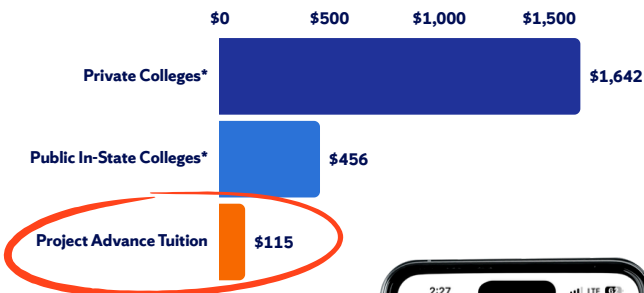
## Instructor Benefits
